Guidelines for Community Food Co-op Scrip Program

Eligible schools should have missions congruent with the values of the Co-op.

Organizations that have been accepted to participate in the Co-op's scrip program must administer their own scrip program.

Organizations purchase scrip certificates from the Co-op at a 5% discount; minimum purchase is \$100; supporters of a particular school purchase the certificates at full-face value directly from that school.

Proceeds from the scrip must be used for education programs.

Scrip certificates are the same as cash and schools are encouraged to pass that message on to participants: lost or stolen gift certificates will not be replaced by the Co-op.

There is a limit of \$500 in scrip donations (5% of \$10,000 in scrip-certificate purchases) for each education program per annum (January to December).
